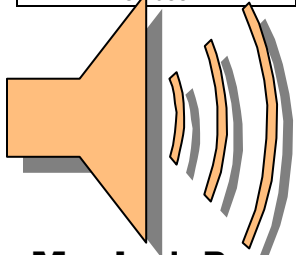

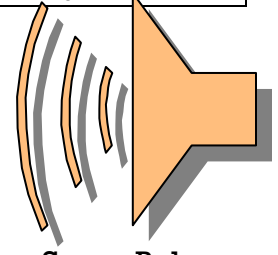

**October's Program –** Dale Hanson gave quite an informative lecture on the Paleontology of the Horse. He is one of four paleontologists for the BLM in the Region including Washington, Oregon, Idaho, Montana, Nebraska and Wyoming. (I hope I got them all) He spoke of the development of the horse with the available "snapshots of time" that we have discovered through their family tree. Eohippus=Hyracotherium who's name was changed to coincide with the earlier discovery in Europe of the same species. Then came Mesohippus- who was a jungle type browser and Miohippus was an intermediate type of animal while the landscape was opening up to include meadows he probably grazed a bit as well as browsed.. Merychippus – was our first true grazer about 18-10 million years ago, he was a 3 toed

species. 16-6 million years ago developed Protohippus – they too were intermediary as some were 1 toed some still featured 3 toes but they were also true grazers. 4.5 million years ago to present day we have what we call and would recognize as our modern day Equus. They became extinct in North America but were reintroduced by the Spaniards in the 16<sup>th</sup> Century. There are 6 living types of Equus 1) Domestic Horse 2) Przewalski's Horse 3) African Ass 4) Grevy's Zebra 5) Mountain Zebra 6) Quagga which became extinct sometime in the mid 1800's. Thank you Dale it was a great presentation!
